



NOTICE OF RACE
Sailhorse Eurocup 2022
from May 26th – May 28th 2022

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 Commercial shipping has priority on all Berlin waterways.
- 1.3 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence. For the national prescriptions of the German Sailing Federation (DSV), the notice of race and the sailing instructions the German text will take precedence.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to boats of the sailhorse Class.
- 2.2 The person in charge shall provide either a valid licence of DSV. Members of other national associations shall provide an equivalent licence issued by their national authority.
- 2.3 Each competitor shall be a member of a club affiliated to his national authority of World Sailing.
- 2.4 Eligible boats shall enter by completing the online entry form on the website <https://www.manage2sail.com/e/EC2022> until may 22th, 2020 and paying the required fees.

3. FEES

- 3.1 Required fees are as follows:

- 3.2 The entry fee shall be paid to the bank account of Sailhorse Klassenvereinigung e.V. at Postbank, BIC: PBNKDEFF, IBAN: DE 37 100100100635666106 naming EC 2022, the name of the helmsman/boat and the sail number.
- 3.3 The entry fee shall be paid upon entering, even if the entry is cancelled later or the boat does not show up. The entry fee is non-refundable, except for the regatta or class being cancelled by the organizing authority or if the entry is rejected.

4. SCHEDULE

4.1 Registration for competitors, coaches and team leaders is scheduled as follows:

4.2 On the first scheduled racing day a skippers meeting will be held at 10:30 hrs. Details will be published in the Sailing Instructions.

4.3 The schedule of races and dates of racing is as follows:

4.4 In the last day of racing, no warning signal will be made after 16:00 hrs.

5. MEASUREMENTS

5.1 Each boat shall have a valid measurement certificate.

5.2 After each race, boats scored 1st, 2nd and 3rd may be subject to an equipment inspection.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at registration.

7. VENUE

7.1 The Events will be hosted at Clubhouse of SVUH.

7.2 The race office will be located at "Schifferzimmer SVUH".

7.3 The racing area will be at "Große Breite, Unter-Havel"

8. COURSES

The courses will be defined in the sailing instructions.

9. SCORING

9.1 The Low Point System will apply.

9.2 There will be a valid Championship when 5 scoring races have been completed.

9.3 When less than 8 races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her scores.

9.4 When 8 or more of the scheduled races has been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

9.5 When 11 or more of the scheduled races has been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her 2 worst scores.

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while they are in the boat park or harbour.

10. RADIO COMMUNICATION

10.1 Except in an emergency or when using equipment provided by the organizing authority, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

11. PRIZES

11.1 Prizes will be awarded to the best three overall scored boats.

12. MEDIA RIGHTS, CAMERAS AND ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT

12.1 By participating in the event competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the athlete during the period of the competition without compensation.

13. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY COGNOVITS CLAUSE

13.1 The responsibility for the decision to participate in a race or to continue with it is solely with the skipper; to that extent the skipper also accepts full responsibility for the crew. The skipper is responsible for the qualification and the correct nautical conduct of the crew as well as for the suitability and the transport-safe-condition of the registered boat. In cases of force majeure or on grounds of administrative orders or for safety reasons, the organizer is entitled to make changes in the realization of the event or to cancel the event. This does not constitute any liability by the organizer towards the participant, if the reasons for the changes or the cancellation do not result from a willful or grossly negligent behaviour of the organizer. In case of a violation of obligations that do not constitute primary or material contractual duties (cardinal obligations), the liability of the organizer for financial and property damages incurred by the participant during or in connection with the participation in the event and resulting from a conduct of the organizer, its representatives, servants or agents, is restricted to damages that were caused willfully or grossly negligent. When a violation of cardinal obligations occurs due to minor negligence, the liability of the organizer is limited to foreseeable, typical damages. To the extent that the liability for damages of the organizer is excluded or restricted, the participant also relieves the staff - employees and representatives, agents, servants, sponsors and individuals who provide or drive salvage, safety or rescue vessels or assist with their use - from the individual liability for damages, as well as all other individuals who were instructed to act in connection with the realization of the event.

13.2 The effective racing rules of World Sailing, the administrative regulations regatta-sailing and the articles of association of DSV, the class rules as well as the regulations of the invitation to the competition and the sailing instructions are to be complied with and are expressly recognized.

13.3 The German law shall prevail.

13.4 Competitors shall present a signed and completed consent and declaration form at registration. For competitors under 18 years of age these forms shall be signed by a parent or guardian. 14. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid (and for the racing area suitable) third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 1.000.000 EUR per incident or the equivalent.

15. PRIVACY POLICY
